Maria wondered why I was used for the birth of Savior. Little village in Galilee Nazareth. I must have thought of this poor, low class. Congratulations, I wonder how many times I remember the words of angels with those who are rich, who are more, more rich, rich, and famous people living in a big town.

8:37 but in all these things we have a brilliant victory by those who love us.

8:38 Death, life, angel, control, present, future, and power

8:39 but those who are at high places, those in the low, and any other objects, cannot be withdrawn from the love of God, which is indicated by our Lord Jesus Christ.

Accept God's will. What the LORD says is thought to be realized even if we don't worry. Since

God's good work is within the best of God, I realized that it was good for me to throw away all other worries and such things in front of God, and put God in front of me, and to look forward to it.

In this hymn, there are many words that refer to Maria and "I".

This is because I have kept my eyes in order for the Lord, who has a low class. From now on, the people of the world will say I am a lucky person

1:49 for the mighty things I have done to me. The name is precious; 1:50 that mercy is not limited to generations, but to those who fear the Lord.

I am the little little who is the Lord of this Lord. I will say to you that I will say to you that I will be happy for you, because I have kept my eyes in this world. For the power has done me great. His name is precious.

1:50 the mercy is not long, but to those who fear the Lord.

Maria's trouble was blown away by the care that God had kept me in sight. For this little God will hold my eyes, and the power has made me great, and I am not afraid. The LORD did this to me. When we were lucky, we were changed to three people who were pleased with it. There may be anguish. Maybe I don't go there. But the Lord will hold our eyes. A mighty thing will do me great.
