

John5:19 So Jesus answered them, "I tell you the truth: the Son can do nothing on his own; he does only what he sees his Father doing. What the Father does, the Son also does.

30 "I can do nothing on my own authority; I judge only as God tells me, so my judgment is right, because I am not trying to do what I want, but only what he who sent me wants.

20 For the Father loves the Son and shows him all that he himself is doing. He will show him even greater things to do than this, and you will all be amazed.

28 Do not be surprised at this; the time is coming when all the dead will hear his voice

21 Just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, in the same way the Son gives life to those he wants to.

29 and come out of their graves: those who have done good will rise and live, and those who have done evil will rise and be condemned.

22 Nor does the Father himself judge anyone. He has given his Son the full right to judge,

27 And he has given the Son the right to judge, because he is the Son of Man.

23 so that all will honor the Son in the same way as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent him.

26 Just as the Father is himself the source of life, in the same way he has made his Son to be the source of life.

24 "I am telling you the truth: those who hear my words and believe in him who sent me have eternal life. They will not be judged, but have already passed from death to life.

25 I am telling you the truth: the time is coming-the time has already come-when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear it will come to life.

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21-20      29-28

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Good morning everyone. January, it only left about 1 week. It is this time to feel that the day has become long. The cold days lasted, but I hope to spend warm days this week.

Now John's gospel came until the latter half of chapter five.

There is a table of numbers along with the holy phrase above, but I found that there was a repetition of expression in this passage.

Sections 19 and 30, 21 and 29, 20 and 28, 22 and 27, 23 and 26, and 24 to 24. And, the last word and the latter word are paired with the wonder. And climb up the stairs and reach the peak and fall down. I noticed that such a structure, which I had heard before, came back again and again, and I had an eye on the emphasis. It is cooperation of saying that Jesus is the center of salvation. Let's taste it together.

19 and 30 are the first pair.

19 and Jesus said to them, "If you don't see your father, you can't do anything from yourself. 30 I can't do anything by myself. Just judge from father. My judgment is right. For I will do my heart, not to my will. "

It is a translation that both are written in common with "cannot do anything from oneself, nothing". In verse 19, "if you don't see your father, you can't do anything from yourself." And in verse 30, he said, "just judge from my father, and my judgment is right, because I will not be my own will, but I will try to bring my heart to me." It is said that 30 sections are emphasized as the emphasis on the repetition of the preceding 19 sections and the reinforcement.

Judge from the father. Jesus is clearly speaking that my judgment is right because it is not his will, but he will go to the heart of God the father who sent Jesus. I can't do anything from myself. Even God, the son of God, God, himself, was the Father God before, but it is the figure as a model for the person who came for us. It is the appearance that has appeared for us. We can't do anything from ourselves, but when we try to do whatever our father does, and when we try to do so, when we pray, we will show our strength to us, when we try to do our own will, not our will. Here is the center of salvation by Jesus.

And 20 and 28 are contrasting.

20 for his father loves his son and shows all his things to him. You will be surprised to see a larger child than these things.

28 When time comes, everyone in the grave listens to the voice of the son of man

It is interesting to say, "you will be surprised" or "I am not surprised".

21 the son gives life to the person who wants to give, so that his father revives the dead and gives him life. It becomes surprising, but it is not surprising.

"I can't do anything for myself, because I will not be my own will, but I will try to bring my heart to me."

28 When time comes, everyone who is in the grave listens to the voice of the son of man, and the person who has done the good comes out to revive and to judge for the resurrection to receive the life.

It is spoken by Jesus that the person who has heard the voice of the man of the person, and done the good, and the person who has done the evil revive, revive, receive the life, and judge.

Jesus is said to be such a voice. The person who revives the people in all death and gives life to the good. It is Jesus.

It becomes surprising, but it is not surprising. Surprisingly, it is not surprising. Isn't it the life of our faith?

The other day, I was surprised to hear that a big earthquake suddenly came in the middle of the night. There are many things that are surprising in our life. We don't know what to do. But surprisingly, it is not surprising. Everything is in God's hand.

God expresses amazing amazing things in our lives. Redeem, we count for good, lead us into life.

20 for his father loves his son and shows all his things to him. You will be surprised to see a larger child than these things.

The Father God loved his son and showed him the amazing work. And he said, "there is a

greater work than these things," he said, saying, "21, that is, the father will resurrect the dead and give him life, and the son will give life to those who want to give him."

Not only that, but John 14:12 says:

"I will tell you, for those who believe in me will do the work I do, and do more work, because I will go to my father."

In verse 30, I said, "I will not be able to do anything by myself, but I will try to keep the heart of the one who has sent me to hear from my father," and Jesus told me that I would be able to do my will. I can't do anything for myself. However, it is common to us that we can be the heart of the dispatch God.

"The one who believes in me will do the work I do, and I will do more work." Although it is "surprising", it is not surprising.

"Because your father loves your son and shows you everything he is doing; and you will be surprised to see his great work more than these things; he will give life to those who want to give him the life of his father."

22 and the father did not judge anyone, and the judgment was left to the child.

27 he also gave him the authority to judge. Because children are children.

23 because all men will respect their children, as they honor their father. Those who do not honor children will not respect their father who sent them.

26 because his father had his own life, he had his son in his own life.

The LORD had the power of judgment, but the world did not fear him. He had his life, but he did not want to live in his life.

The man who is proud of arrogance is far away from life without fear of the person who was

sent either.

John 1:3 It was composed, and there was nothing that was made without words.

1:4 there was life in the word. Life was light that illuminated man.

1:5 light shines in the dark. Darkness did not understand the light.

1:9 the light comes from the light of the light and illuminates all men.

1:10 the word was in the world. The world was made by the word, but the world did not accept the word.

1:11 the word came to his people, but the people did not accept.

What if it does not honor the Savior, even if the person who has got the life, the person who gets eternal life, the light that illuminates the person, and the life that saved the person came, but does not honor the Savior. It is written here that Jesus is the center of salvation, and that it is Jesus who sent us.

And verses 24 and 25 are the peak.

24 Those who believe in those who have heard me, and who have sent me, have eternal lives, and are judged from death to life.

25 The time will come when the dead will hear the son of God. Now is that time. Those who hear the voice live.

I have to say clearly. It is written in the original Greek word "Amen, Amen". It really means that I tell you. We say "amen" at the end of the prayer. Jesus wants me to hear this word, and since this word is true, I repeat it to hear my words.

I'll tell you clearly. Those who believe in those who have heard me, and who have sent me, have eternal lives, and are judged from death to life.

I'll tell you clearly. The time will come when the dead will hear the son of God. Now is that time. Those who hear the voice live.

I want you to hear my words. The one who sent me was the God of creation of heaven and earth. I want you to believe that this was sent me. And I want you to believe in my words. And I want you to follow the words. From the bottom of my heart I wish you. I want to hear from you and believe in the bottom of my heart. Then, "you have eternal life, and you are judged

from death to life." Said he. Those who have the power of judgment say clearly that they are not judged. I don't think it's so clear. And the same shall be said, "the time will come when the dead will hear the voice of the son of God. Now, that is the time. The person who heard the voice will live." Therefore, Jesus is speaking at this peak as I want to obey me.

This is a remarkable place where there are many surprising things. "If you trust me, do not be surprised, look at my example of the will of you who have been sent, and look at me who is dead and resurrected, and you will hear the voice of the son of God, who has gone from life to death without being judged, and judged, from death to life." The Lord is told to be sure that he is sending his life. Life that the Lord is with, and death is transferred to life. "Because your father loves your son and shows you everything he is doing, and you will be surprised to see the big business for him." We become more and more aware of the tastes of life.

Jesus is the center of salvation. We wish you to open your heart for the purpose of the person who has heard the voice of him.
