How surprised was the chief priests who were traveling in Passover? When he slaughtered the sheep, people felt fear that Jesus had taken breath and that many strange events happened.

22:20 help my life from the power of the dog, from my soul.

22:21 from me, out of the mouth of my servant, rescue my suffering from the horn of the bull.

22:22 I will tell you my name to my brothers, and praise you in the congregation.

12:51 on the very day, the LORD was led by the people of Israel in accordance with his Corps.

9:1 the first year of the year, exiting the land of Egypt, the LORD said to Moses, in the wilderness of Sinai
