Matthew 1:23 "look, my uncle will give birth to a baby boy, whose name will be called immanuel". This means that we are with God.

Isaiah chapter

4:8 I am the Lord, this is my name. I will not give my glory to others. Moreover, it is not given to the image engraved with my honor.

4:9 Behold, the prophecy came up. I will tell you something new. Let me know you first before it happens.

4:10 sing the new song. Praise the Lord from the fruit. The sea and the ones in it, the countries

along the sea, and those who live in it.

4:11 the wilderness and all the cities in it, and the old village village of kedane. The people of sera are glad. Call at the top of the mountain.

4:12 and return glory to the Lord, and tell thee in the countries along the sea.

42:13 the LORD goes out like a brave man, raises enthusiasm like a man, calls him with his voice, and turns out to be a mighty man.

4:14 I did not cry for a long time, and kept silent, Now I cry like a woman who is giving birth. My breath breaks out.

42:15 I will destroy the mountains and hills, and wipe all the grass, and let the great rivers be the island, and all the ponds.

42:16 I will make my eyes go to the path that they still don't know, guide them to the path that I still don't know, and make the darkness light before that, and flatten heights. I do not do these things.

4:17 and to ask the idoling idol, to the cast idol, who says, "you are our God," is dismissed, and it is very shame.

Hear me, hear. Take a look at your eyes.

4:19 do you have any other ideas for my servant? Is there any ear like an emissary with whom you keep? Does anyone have such a dedication? Is there any eye like the servant of the Lord?

4:20 he does not recognize even if he sees a lot of things, and will not listen to his ears.

42:21 the Lord pleaded to be great and honored for his righteousness.

4:22 but the people were shrouded and robbed, and all were caught in the pit and confined in the prison. Even if they are blurred, there is no one to help them, and no one says, "let it go."

42:23 who will listen to this, who will use your heart?

4:24 but who has robbed Jacob? Who is the man who has made Israel a fool? Isn't this the main? We did not like to go to the Lord and to go to the road, and to obey the doctrine.

4:25 but the LORD came to them with fierce anger and fierce battle. Even if it burnt around like fire, they did not understand and burned them.

Matthew 12:17 this is the prophecy of Isaiah, for prophecy,

12:18 "Behold, I who I chose, my heart, my beloved, I will give my spirit to him, and he will give justice to the Gentiles.

12:19 he doesn't contend and shouldn't cry, nor hear the voice on the street.

12:20 until he has won the justice, he never breaks down the reed, and does not extinguish the smoke.

12:21 the Gentiles will put hope in his name.

Isaiah

5:1 but who did we believe? Who was the arm of the Lord?

5:2 he grew up like a young tree before the Lord, like a root out of a pretty soil. He has no form to be seen, dignified, and no beauty for us.

5:3 he was despised, abandoned by man, and he knew the disease. He was despised, like a man who covered his face. We did not admire him.

5:4 and indeed he suffered our illness and became our sorrow. But we thought, he was struck, struck by God, and suffered.

5:5 but he was hurt for our sake and was broken for our misery. He gave us peace, and he was done by his wound.

5:6 we all lost like sheep and went to our own way. And the Lord placed upon us the wrong of

all men.

5:7 he was hurt and tormented, but he did not open his mouth. He did not open his mouth, like a lamb, which was driven by a bark, and as a silent sheep before his hair cut.

5:8 he was taken away by an atrocity. Who would have thought of that man, he was struck for the sake of my people, and was cut off from the land of the living.

5:9 he did not make a tyranny, and there was no lie in his mouth, but the grave was established with the evil, and the mound was with evil.

5:10 and crushing him was the Lord, and the LORD was troubled by him. When he makes himself an offering, he can see his descendants, and he can increase his life. And the Lord will flourish by his hand.

5:11 he is satisfied with the light of his soul. The righteous servants are righteous by their knowledge and make many righteous.

5:12 therefore, I share him with the great. He divides the game with the strong. This is because he has taken up his soul until he died, and counted with him. In addition, he suffered many people's sin, and took it for a certain person.

Matthew 8:17 this is because the prophet Isaiah fulfills the words which he said, "he has received our slightest and suffered our disease."

Luke 22:37 but you must be made to me that he is counted as one of the sins. Yes, it is fulfilled.

Daniel 7:13 I saw again in the phantom of the night, and behold, a man like a son of man, came upon the cloud of heaven, and came to the old man of the day before he was led.

7:14 he gave him sovereignty, honor and country, and made him serve people, people, and languages. The sovereignty is eternal sovereignty, it is not lost, and the country cannot perish.

Matthew 24:30 then the sign of the son of man will appear in heaven. And then all people in

the land will lament, and with power and great glory, people will see the son of man aboard the clouds of heaven.

Behold, 5:2 but Bethlehem ephata, you are small among the sons of Judah, but those who govern Israel will come out of you. It comes from the day when it comes out.

Matthew 2:6 "the land of Judah, Bethlehem, you will never be the least of the people of Judah, and you will come out of you, and you will be the servant of my people Israel."

5:40 but you will not come to me to get your life.

5:41 but I will not receive my honor.

5:42 but you know that there is no love loving God.

5:43 I have come by my father's name, but you will not receive me. If another person comes by his own name, he will receive him.

5:44 but how can you believe that thou shalt not seek the honor of God alone?

5:45 don't think I will sue you for my father. The man who appeals to you is the Moses who you ask.

5:46 if you believed Moses, I would have believed in me. Moses wrote about me.

5:47 but why don't you believe in my words if you don't believe in Moses? "

Even in this Scripture, Jesus is written in the Bible about the glory after that hardship, and Jesus spoke, but the disciples who forgot about it and worried about it. And today we are the same.

24:35 they spoke on the way, and the fact that he found Jesus in a state of bread.

"When we talked about the Scriptures, and when we preached the Scriptures, we could have burned our hearts together," and they said that the sun was inclined, and the rest of the mind was going to rest, and joy and power came out of our hearts, and we took back 11 kilometers of the road and went back to Jerusalem. He told the brothers and sisters of this joy, and was pleased and forced. In the midst of the difficulties, I hope that the light will be lighted in the heart by the words that point to Jesus, and the heart will burn into passion, share the emotions with each other, and live together.

It is the power to brighten our hearts and burn our hearts.

Jesus will always love us, feed you, pray for blessings, eat bread, call him, and give us a holy dinner, we will always be my memorial, and we will be able to bring our heart to Jesus who is told to be with us, and hope to continue to believe, hope, and hope for you.
