7 the disciple who loved Jesus said to Peter, "that is the Lord." When he heard that Simon Peter was the Lord, he was naked, and took his coat and plunged into the sea.

12 Jesus said to them, "come and eat the morning." Since the disciples knew that he was the Lord, no one would ask, "who are you?"

Indeed, Jesus appeared to his disciples to inform us that he was the Lord. It was because the disciples believed Jesus as the Savior and had the life.

31 but to write these things is to believe that you are Jesus, the son of God, and to believe in it, and to live by the name of Jesus.

2 Simon Peter was with Dedham, Thomas, tanathael of Galilee, children of zbedi, and other disciples.

The disciples were together. Once it was shaking with a key in it, Thomas didn't know what reason, but he was not in the gathering, but now they were together.

Bull 10:25 but as some people always do, don't stop gathering, encourage each other, and see how the sun is approaching, and so much more.

2:3 Simon Peter said to them, "I will go fishing," they said, "let us go together." They went out

and got on the boat. But that night he had no game.

21:4 when daybreak came, Jesus stood on the shore. But the disciples did not know it was Jesus.

They stood for help. Jesus came to his disciples and showed his appearance, and they helped them out of the air. However, the disciples who used to be a fisherman were not able to get any prey that night. Even though he struggled all night, the trouble was not rewarded.

Do we have such a thing? It is not rewarded even if it tries hard. When it is not given it is necessary to live. We lose sight of the Lord, so often disappointed. The disciples did not know that it was Jesus, even though they were standing near the shore of the lake about 90 meters long. The Lord manifests himself, and the Lord is trying to demonstrate his main power, but we don't notice it. I tried to take all night. It is the same as the scene of the miracle of the great catch that was summoned by Peter, chapter five. However, when this becomes a thing, it cannot be noticed. That pinch makes its grief a great pleasure. By the power of the Lord of the resurrection, by grace, there was a figure of the disciples who were unable to believe that fear could change into joy, and with the eyes of sadness and emptiness, who lost the wings of faith and exhausted.

We have a troubled, troubled past. In the future, there was a situation where there was no way to find any way, and there was a situation where there was a deadlock, a dead end, and eight sides. But what was it then? After that, did you stay stuffed now?

There must be fierce circumstances that attack us from now on. But we must not forget that the Lord is in the situation.

5 Jesus said to them, "do they have something to eat?" They replied.

You are standing on the shore of 90 meters ahead. We are floating on the water, and there is no harvest from the lake, and there is a lot of blurry, but the Lord is watching all the way from the shore, and we know that we have fallen off the shoulder without hitting anything. We don't realize the existence, and we will struggle with our armies, and God will not understand us and will not help us. And we will call us, and we will know that we have eaten something, or that nothing has happened.

If you know it, you can send the power from it without getting nasty and try to catch the fish. Why are you not looking for help? Why do you take it easy to look at the difficult figure? We may think like that.

20:29 Jesus said to him, "did you believe in seeing me?"

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Isn't it all because this word is made? In order to be able to believe in the next thing, no matter how hard it may or may not be seen, even if it is difficult or unfinished, the Lord confessed that 'the Lord is coming,' and waited for the Lord to wait and wait for the Lord to be able to wait for him.

6 and Jesus said to them, "put the net on the right side of the boat, and look at it." When they put the net, they could not raise it because they were so much fish.

That's it. This is the power of the Lord. There's no way to drop the net to the right of the ship, down to the left, or to the back, even when there is no fish. When the fish are burning around

the night, the fish will come to the place where it is bright. However, there was no fish at all. And now, even though the sky is white, what is the person who is blessed to leave the net on the right side of the boat? "What do you have to eat?" The disciples might have wondered. But the disciples still did not know who it was.

It was a very pure disciple, even if it was mysterious, but even as he said, The reason why they were chosen as a disciple was that there was such a pure feeling in the weakness of the Lord who would leave the Lord and run away, and in the weakness that they had forgotten the words of the Lord.

They dropped the net in the words of the Lord. And then the fish fell. It was a large group of fish that I had never seen, so I could not raise it. How could you predict how they were able to rewind a clock a little ago and be surprised and delighted at such an expansion?

7 the disciple who loved Jesus said to Peter, "that is the Lord." When he heard that Simon Peter was the Lord, he was naked, and took his coat and plunged into the sea.

8 but the other disciples, with their boat, returned home with a net of fish. It was about fifty miles away from the land.

John finally noticed. It's the event of that time. "He is the Lord,"

As Peter hurried to the grave of the Lord, he jumped into the lake and jumped into the lake and went to the Lord to swim. The Lord has been with us now! I want to see you. He comes near to the Lord at full speed. How many seconds did he swim in 90 meters? About two minutes? Is it half a minute? He wanted to meet Jesus. He could not live without Jesus.

9 when they went up to the land, there was a charcoal fire, a fish on it, and a bread there.

10 Jesus said to them, bring a little fish now.

11 when Simon Peter went up to the land, he was filled with a large fish of five hundred and three. Although it was so many, the net was unavoidable.

The other disciples also reached land with a boat. There was a charcoal fire. Warm up your body. And Jesus baked the fish and prepared bread. The fish they had caught in the fish Jesus prepared. They were 153 fish in total. But the net was not broken.

12 Jesus said to them, "come and eat the morning." Since the disciples knew that he was the Lord, no one would ask, "who are you?"

13 and Jesus came there, and gave them bread and gave them the same fish.

14 it was the third time that the disciples had already appeared after Jesus recovered from the dead.

Now he did not do what he asked, because he found it was the Lord. We are also the same. Jesus is the Lord, who is always near, knows us, and understands us even if we don't know it. In this way we continue to show ourselves.

We believe in him and believe in him.
