

Acts 1:3 to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

1:4 And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me;

1:5 "for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

1:6 Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?"

1:7 And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority.

1:8 "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

1:9 Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight.

1:10 And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel,

1:11 who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

Good morning everyone.

At the end of May, the sunlight in the daytime became the sunshine of summer. We would like to enjoy enough green season until rainy season.

How have you been?

Well, I've been reading the gospel of John for a long time.

8 "but when the Holy Spirit dwells to you, you will receive power, and you will be my witness to Jerusalem, the Judea and the whole of Samaria, and to the earth."

This is the word of the powerful missionary order of the Lord who dispatches disciples to World Evangelism. And it is written in the apostles by the Holy Spirit that the disciples will

speak in Pentecostal and in the language of the foreign language which does not learn, and that this is a symbolic event, and the Holy Spirit makes a big mission of the world mission, and the vision realizes the reality.

Today, we can see from the words of this word, to see the idea of the man who seeks to know when the time is, the decision by God's authority, and our attitude to "wait for the promise of God", and to think about "our country" or to think about the "Kingdom of God".

We live in time after time. Even if you think of a good thing and try to invite a person, the reality is poor in "breath" of "ain" and "Aun breath", and it becomes realistic saying "what and how many days in every month". There is a fight to fight for one second under the word "early win". In the upper and lower parts of the stock market price, there is a price movement for one second or less. It is good to be able to send a letter and put it in the post, but it is an age with the e-mail by line, and it is transmitted to the partner immediately. It is required to ask for immediate results.

3 after he had suffered hardships, he showed his life by many definite evidences, and appeared in them over forty days and spoke of the kingdom of God.

Jesus had suffered hardships and died on the cross, but it was written in the end of the gospel that he was revived on the third day and showed it to his disciples repeatedly. Jesus made his disciples appear, and the number of days has passed over 40 days. This year's Easter was April 17. If the first day Jesus became the day, it would be until May 26th for 40 days. We had an egg in Easter and played a handbell, and from that time on, Jesus often appeared in his disciples over 40 days from today till three days before. And because Pentecost is next week today, it was about 10 days that the disciples were really waiting for themselves. Pentecost (Pentagon) is the 50th day of the festival, but on the forty four days, four fifths of them were with disciples. I want to see what kind of gentle Jesus is.

4 and when they were eating together, they commanded them, "keep away from Jerusalem, and wait for the promise of my father, who had ever heard from me.

Jesus encouraged the disciples and said he would not leave Jerusalem. There was a temple in Jerusalem, where there were priests and priests who crucified Jesus on the cross. But at the end of the gospel,

24:50 then Jesus took them to Bethany and raised them and blessed them.

24:51 they were blessed, leaving them [to heaven]

24:52 they returned to Jerusalem with great joy

24:53 he was always at the temple and praised God.

The last part of the gospel of Luke and the passage of the apostles known as Luke's writings are the events of today. The disciples were shown to the disciples over 40 days after suffering, and were shown by many definite evidences that they were alive, so they stayed in Jerusalem as they were told, and were continually in praise of God. And, "always awaiting father's promise from Jesus".

5 John gave baptism in water, but you will soon be baptized by the Holy Spirit.

In the Jordan River, we were able to immerse ourselves in the water, wash up and retire, change our direction towards God, and start with a new life, but Jesus promised to be able to walk into the whole new life, though we filled the whole body of the Holy Spirit with the whole body of the disciples.

"You ought to wait for my father's promise."

We said, but we are not good at waiting. I want a result soon. Even if it promises, the word of the reliable person is said, and even if it says, I want some confirmation. For that reason, Jesus said, "how many times have you lived in your life?" But the disciples were more interested in the country where they lay themselves than waiting for the present.

6 and when the disciples gathered together, they asked Jesus, and said, "Lord, is this time to restore the country for Israel?"

Is this time? And what happens to the reconstruction of Israel's country?

Said the Lord,

7 and they said to them, "the time and in the case your father is determined by your authority, not as much as you know.

"Time and place", "time and time" (new translation) are determined by their own authority. Not as far as you know.

Really. How many years, what days, hours and minutes, and what kind of cruise. We want to know everything like that. Therefore, the fortune telling and the fortune judgment are always popular. But all of us are not as much as we know, and when and how it is, God's father is determined by his authority. We don't have to know so much detail. If we know it, we wonder how many days we get sick, how we get involved in a traffic accident, or when we get to heaven, we can't be afraid of living. But we should believe and wait for the good things God promised us. God, the father of God, who loves us, has promised us good things, and when we are in Jerusalem, in the temple, at present, in the church, in worship, in prayer and in trust, the Father God is good at the good time in his authority, at the good time We make a good thing for us.

Ecclesiastes

3:1 To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven:

3:2 A time to be born, And a time to die; A time to plant, And a time to pluck what is planted;

3:3 A time to kill, And a time to heal; A time to break down, And a time to build up;

3:4 A time to weep, And a time to laugh; A time to mourn, And a time to dance;

3:5 A time to cast away stones, And a time to gather stones; A time to embrace, And a time to refrain from embracing;

3:6 A time to gain, And a time to lose; A time to keep, And a time to throw away;

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

May be uneasy. There may be some anxiety that you don't know someday.

But there is a word that sparkles here.

"But"

When the Holy Spirit comes to you, you receive power!

In the heart of the heart, but in the heart of an uneasiness, but after the words of the Holy Spirit, you shall follow the word that you receive power.

"Power" was at the end of last week's Luc 24 victory, but this is a great word. "Power" is a word of strength, power, miracle, supernatural power, ability, talent, aptitude, nature, possibility, means, means of financial power. Everything you need to do is really packed in this language. It is by the Holy Spirit that we receive the power to make and realize such things. And you will be a witness to all the land of Jerusalem, Judah, and Samaria, and to the earth.

The disciples asked, "is this time to revive the country for Israel?" But God spoke about the kingdom of God. The kingdom of God refers to all of this world where the LORD was built, "Jerusalem, Judah and the whole of Samaria. The disciples do not wish only to think about the place where they belong. We are not only thinking about us, our family, the church, our church, and the Christian world. We should also think about the whole world from close to far, and pray for the reconstruction, pray for reconstruction, and pray for comfort. To this end, it becomes the witness of Jesus Christ. It is revival of the land in the land, reconstruction, and think of the country of God.

Jesus said in chapter six of Matthew.

6:33 first ask God's Kingdom and the righteousness of God. And all these will be given with all.

11 "the people of Galilee, why are you standing in the heavens of heaven, and that Jesus, who has left you and ascended to heaven, will be in the same way as you saw him ascended to heaven."

When the disciples looked up at the sky and stood up with pokeran, the angels stood near them in a dazzling white coat.
